Things to know

LOcREaDO Dance Program will run only on Sundays 9am-1pm

Program starts Sunday September 8th 9am-1pm

Location will be **(Mapa studios 140 Hall St Spotswood)** this will also be the location for our Audition on September 1st.

Audition will be on 01/09/24

Juniors age 10-13 at 9am-12pm. Seniors age 14-18 at
12:30pm-3:30pm

Audition attire (Full black dance wear)

You will be asked to fill out a registration form and will require a parent or guardian to fill out a section of the form on the day.

Please note Audition will be filmed and footage from the audition may be posted on our social media pages.

Successful dancers will be notified with an offer by Monday September 2nd, you are expected to accept your offer no later than September 3rd Tuesday 6pm. Dancers who are not successful will be notified by Wednesday September 4th. This will be done by email and text. There may be the possibility that we put some dancers on hold in the event a spot becomes available.

Program fees are \$1120 which includes costumes. This works out to be \$80 per week, 4 hours studio time and costumes for the show is included in the price as well as dancers headshots for the show.

Payment options for the program are: Weekly, Fortnightly, Monthly or Full fees paid up front.

Important information : Fees are paid for each dancers position (Spot) in the program and not the days of attendance, so regardless of attendance the full fees will need to be paid.

Performance venue will be at Gasworks Theatre (TBC) and we are anticipating the show to be on Monday December 9th or Tuesday December 10th

WHAT TO EXPECT

LOcREaDO Dance Program has been operating since 2010 under the direction of Loreda Malcolm, Loreda Malcolm has been in the performing arts Industry for 21 years and is still currently performing. Loreda has performed in 17 Commercial Musical Theatre shows including The Lion King, Hairspray, Wicked, Chicago, Hamilton, Rocky Horror Show, La Cage, and currently performing with Tina Turner the Musical. Loreda Malcolm has been teaching/mentoring since 2009 and was also Top 9 in So You Think You Can Dance in 2009. Loreda also owns LOcREaDO Dance Company and as choreographed over 20 works shown across Australia and Asia

This 14 week program is to give the dancers not only experience but to also give them something new, to allow them to grow in a different environment, and be in a new environment with new people and new choreographers, the program is designed to give the dancers an opportunity to learn choreography in a quicker time frame, and do their independent home work on their material, it allows them to be able to learn from different teachers as well as their fellow dancers. As the industry is ever changing, programs like these should be encouraged and it is always beneficial for dancers to really get as much exposure as possible while they still can.

This will be a Fosse Inspired/Contemporary/Theatre show called "LIMITLESS"

LOcREaDO Program Rules

Attendance : Please note it is ok if a dancer has commitments on some Sundays that may require them to be absent, late or leave early, we understand that there may be studio commitments, competitions or family events, please do let us know in advance if this will be your situation and we will work out a plan. Please don't let that be a deciding factor for you to do the program or not, we always have options.

Routines and Rehearsals : Once we start this program a Whatsapp group will be created for each group, these chat groups will be used to send all videos from rehearsals so the dancers can do their revision each week, you will also get this as a dropbox link with videos and music from each rehearsal every week, we ask parents to make sure to give their child access to the videos so they can revise.

If you are absent you will have the opportunity to learn what you missed out on from the videos and if you do this in your own time you will be placed in the routine section you missed out on, however this will be the responsibility of the dancer to learn sections they missed and the team will then slot them in to those sections. We of course prefer dancers not to miss sessions but we understand that may be a possibility so this will be the outcome if that happens.

Costumes: Costumes will be chosen by Loreda Malcolm for the show.

Teaching Team: Loreda Malcolm, Nina Dell, Kim Choi and others.
